**Overview:** Understanding The Joint Commission’s Emergency Management (EM) chapter and helping your organization maintain compliance with these standards is beneficial for proper emergency preparation. This program is offered the day before the 2024 Emergency Preparedness Conference and teaches those new to emergency management about the requirements and how to incorporate strategies and develop plans and other strategic initiatives for emergency management preparedness and response.
